Prospectus for Admissions to PG / Ph D Program 2017

The candidates should fill separate application form for applying for each M. Tech program .

HOW TO FILL APPLICATION FORM

There are 3 Simple Steps to be followed to apply online:

Step 1: Fill the Online Application Form, choose your Password and note down system generated Application Number.

The candidate should supply all the details while filling the Online Application Form and also choose PASSWORD and Security Question with her Answer. After successful submission of completed application form an Application number will be generated that will be used to complete the remaining Steps of the Application Form. The application number will be required for all future correspondence. For subsequent logins, candidate will be able to login directly with her respective system generated **Application Number** and chosen **Password**.

Step 2: Upload Scanned Images of Photograph, Signature and Thumb impression and other relevant Documents:

- The scanned images of photograph, Signature and thumb impression should be in **jpg/jpeg** format only.
- Size of the photo image must be greater than 4 kb and less than 100 kb.
- Size of the signature image must be greater than 1 kb and less than 30 kb.

- Size of the thumb impression image must be greater than 1 kb and less than 30 kb.
- Size of the other relevant Documents must be greater than 50 kb and less than 300 kb.
- The Candidate will be able to modify/correct the particulars before the payment of fees.

Step 3:

1. Pay Fee by Net banking/Credit/Debit card: The candidate has to select Net banking/Debit/Credit Card option to pay the application fee and follow the online instruction to complete the payment of fee. After successful payment, candidate will be able to print the acknowledgment Page. In case the acknowledgment page is not generated after payment of fee then the transaction is cancelled and amount will be refunded to the candidate account. However the candidate has to make another transaction till the Acknowledgment Page is not generated

2. Important Instruction about PASSWORD

During online form filling, candidate will be required to choose PASSWORD and Security Question and its Answer. Candidate is advised to record/remember her password for all future logins.

The Password must be as per the following Password policy:

- Password must be 8 to 13 characters long.
 - Password must have at least one Upper case alphabet.
 - Password must have at least one Lower case alphabet.
 - Password must have at least one numeric value.
 - Password must have at least one special characters e.g.!@#\$%^&*-
- For subsequent logins, candidate will be able to login directly with their respective system generated Application Number and the chosen Password.
 - Candidate is advised not to disclose or share their password with anybody. Neither IGDTUW nor NIC will be responsible for violation or misuse of the password of a candidate.
 - Candidate can change her password after login, if desired.
 - Candidate should remember to log out at the end of their session so that the particulars of the candidate cannot be tampered or modified by unauthorized persons.

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Relaxation in marks for reserved categories

Candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes will be allowed 5% relaxation of marks in the minimum eligibility requirement.

Eligibility for Part Time M.Tech (ICT) Programme:

A Candidate who has obtained any of the following qualification with MINIMUM 60% or equivalent in the qualifying examination as under:

- (i) B.E/B. Tech (CS/IT/ECE/EEE/Instrumentation or equivalent)
- (ii) M.Sc.(CSE/IT/ Electronics or equivalent)
- (iii) MCA / DOEACC-B level

Eligibility for MCA Programme:

Bachelor's Degree of a recognized University in any discipline with at least 60% marks in aggregate and must also have passed Mathematics subject (core or elective or functional) at 10+2 level of the CBSE or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto.

OR

BCA/BIT/BIS of a recognized University of at least three years duration with at least 60% marks in aggregate or any qualification recognized as equivalent thereto.

Eligibility for Full Time Ph.D Program:

- i. **For Engineering (CSE, IT, MAE, ECE):** Degree in M.E. / M.Tech or equivalent from a recognized University/ Institution in the relevant discipline with minimum of 60% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA & B.E./B.Tech. or equivalent with minimum of 60% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA.
- ii. **For Computer Application:** MCA from a recognized University/ Institution with minimum of 60% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA & Graduation Degree (with Sciences and Mathematics) with minimum of 60% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA.

- iii. **For Sciences and Humanities (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, English)** :Master Degree in the relevant discipline from a recognized University/Institution with 60% marks or equivalent CGPA & undergraduate degree in the relevant discipline with 60% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA.

Eligibility for Part Time Ph.D Program:

Faculty working in Educational Institutions, Scientists working in R&D Organizations/Labs, Professionals working in a PSUs/Corporate/Industry registered under Company's Act.

Provided that:

- i. The Applicant possesses the minimum entry qualifications for the degree as given in the admission eligibility for Full Time Research Scholars.
- ii. The applicant is presently employed under any of the following categories :
 - a. Applicants working in organizations which have MOU with IGDTUW.
 - b. Applicants working in regular position as Scientist in a National Level R&D Lab/ a reputed organization.
 - c. Applicants working in regular position as faculty in any recognized educational institution / university.
 - d. Regular /Contractual faculty of IGDTUW.
 - e. Applicants working as professional in a PSU/Corporate/Industry registered under Company's Act organization.
- iii. The Applicant possesses at least two years of relevant teaching/research experience in regular capacity.
- iv. The Applicant proves to the satisfaction of the university that her official duties permit her to devote sufficient time to research.
- v. The applicant gets an NOC from her employer.
- vi. Facilities for research are available at the applicant's place of work in the chosen field of research

Eligibility for Junior Research Fellowship:

A student who satisfies the Minimum Eligibility requirement for Full Time Research Scholar.

- i. She has qualified UGC-CSIR-JRF/NET examination or has or qualified GATE with a score above the minimum cut off or qualified RAT examination. A person who has appeared in the above examinations but is awaiting results may also apply. However, she shall be required to produce a valid documentary evidence of having qualified the examination at the time of interview.
- ii. She is not receiving any financial assistance from any other sources.

Admission procedure

Admission Procedure for full time M.Tech programme:

The admission to M.Tech.(Full time) program will be based on the merit of the valid GATE Score secured by candidates and thereafter on the basis of the marks secured in the qualifying examination as per the eligibility.

Admission Procedure for part time M.Tech (ICT) programme:

The admission to M.Tech (ICT) Part time program is on the basis of Merit of the marks obtained in the qualifying examination and work experience. Preference would be given to the candidates having valid GATE score. Preference shall be given to the candidate having professional/teaching experience in the respective field after completing the qualifying examination.

Admission Procedure for MCA programme:

The admission to MCA program of IGDTUW is on the basis of rank secured in the entrance examination conducted by IGDTUW. 85% of the total seats are reserved for candidate belonging to Delhi Region (Students passing the qualifying examination from recognized University / College / Institution located within the NCT of Delhi) and 15% of the total seats for candidates belonging to outside Delhi Region.

ADMISSION PROCESS for Ph.D Programme:

(i) Admission Process to the Ph.D Programme is common to the two categories(Full time and Part time) of applicants.

(iii) Admission shall be made on the basis of a written Screening Test (Research Aptitude Test, RAT) or an interview or both as decided by the Admission Committee of the university.

(iv) The RAT exam may be conducted in a given subject only in case if adequate numbers of applications are not received from the RAT exempted category in that subject. However the application fee of Rs. 750 as deposited by the applicants is non-refundable irrespective of conduct or non-conduct of RAT Examination.

(v) The RAT Exam may be conducted in the following disciplines:

- ii. Computer Science/Information Technology/Computer Applications
- iii. Mechanical Engineering

Those candidates who are seeking provisional admission due to non-declaration of their final year/final semester result, will however have to provide proof of having passed all papers in all the

previous examination along with final result by 30th September 2017 to the University otherwise their admission will be automatically treated as cancelled and the entire fee will be forfeited.

Withdrawal policy for MCA/M.Tech

All the requests for withdrawal of admission in the prescribed Performa (as per Annexure) are to be submitted at IGDTUW. A proper receipt for withdrawal will be issued. The candidates will be required to surrender the original Admission Slip issued at the time of Counseling/Admission while applying for withdrawal of admission. No request for withdrawal of admission would be entertained without admission slip.

- (1) Candidate can withdraw her admission on or before 31st July, 2017. In such case all fee deposited by her will be refunded to her with a deduction of Rs 1000/- .
- (2) If a candidate withdraws her admission after 31st July, 2017 the complete fee paid by her will be forfeited except the security fees.
- (3) Spot round for MCA/M.Tech will be conducted if seat remain vacant and its information will be displayed on university website www.igdtuw.ac.in.

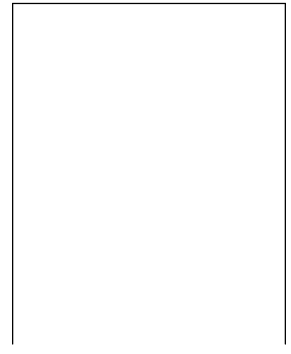
